

Media Holiday Homework

In the Media, teenagers are often represented in the way of “stereotypes” such as jocks, emos, nerds or princesses.

1. Complete the worksheets on Stereotypes.
2. Identify a certain “stereotype” and give a definition of what that stereotype means. Describe the stereotype in terms of things such as dress, attitude, social status and demeanor.
2. Find some representations of your chosen stereotype. Collect at least 6 representations of your stereotype (could be photos, illustrations, youtube videos etc) and discuss how each one of them have been constructed. Mention aspects such as costuming, colours, lighting, camera positioning, body language, casting.
3. Recreate your chosen stereotype, using yourself as the representation. Your representation could be in a variety of formats including photography, a short video clip, a short radio segment or a short animation. Use whatever facilities at your disposal.
4. Complete the ten questions on the film ‘Miss Representation’. Each question should be answered fully and carefully.
